It is hoped that the re-created cross will be unveiled in the grounds of the Cathedral around St Patrick's Day.

Friday, 21st September 2018

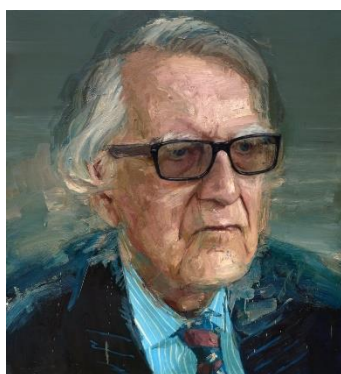
Denvir's Coaching Inn, Downpatrick
